On this the 11th day of February A.D. 1946 came on to be heard the above entitled and numbered cause, and came Plaintiff in person and by her attorney and announced ready for trial, but the Defendant, although he has filed herein a waiver of citation, and entered his appearance herein for all purposes, made no further answer and made default; And a jury being waived, Plaintiff again announced ready for trial; and all matters of fact and of law were submitted to the Court; and the court, having heard the Pleadings and evidence and argument of counsel is of the opinion and finds that this Court has jurisdiction, and that this is a suit for a divorce by Plaintiff against Defendant; and for custody of minor child, and the Court finds that the material allegations in Plaintiff's petition are true, and that Plaintiff is entitled to a divorce and custody of her minor child Louis Fulton Porterfield; and that Defendant should be required to pay the sum of \$40.00 (Forty) per month to Plaintiff for the support of said child;

It is therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that Plaintiff, Ruby Joe Porterfield have and she is hereby granted a Decree of Divorce from Defendant Charles L. Porterfield, and that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between Plaintiff Ruby Joe Porterfield and Defendant Charles L. Porterfield be and the same are hereby forever dissolved.

It is further ORDERED that Plaintiff Ruby Joe Porterfield have and she is hereby granted the care, custody and control of her minor child, Louis Fulton Porterfield; and that Defendant Charles L. Porterfield pay to Plaintiff at San Angelo, Texas the sum of \$40.00 on March 15th A.D. 1946, for the month of February; and that Defendant Charles L. Porterfield pay to Plaintiff Ruby Joe Porterfield at San Angelo, Texas, or to the Clerk of this court for Plaintiff, the sum of \$40.00 on the 15th day of each and every month hereafter until the further orders of this court.

It is further ORDERED that the property settlement agreement between said parties, dated January 11, 1946, a copy of which was introduced in evidence and required by the Court and is filed with the papers herein, be and the same is hereby in all things approved,
